

Editorial Board Conflict of Interest Policy

Outlined below are steps taken when *IJPT* receives a manuscript from authors at the editors' institutions.

Situation	Response
Editor-in-Chief and/or Operating Editor are authors of submitted manuscript.	Journal Manager will note conflict and Managing Editor will choose most appropriate Associate Editor for handling. Authors will be informed of final decision only.
Manuscript is submitted by an employee of the University of Florida College of Medicine Department of Radiation Oncology.	Journal Manager will note conflict and assign an Associate Editor employed by an unrelated institution for handling.
Manuscript is submitted by an Associate Editor or employee of an Associate Editor's institution.	Journal Manager and/or Managing Editor will note conflict and assign an appropriate Associate Editor employed by an unrelated institution for handling.
Member of the <i>IJPT</i> Editorial Staff or an Associate Editor receives/is assigned a manuscript for which he or she believes a conflict exists.	Journal Manager and/or Managing Editor will note conflict and request the oversight of another Editor or Associate Editor.
